Fishlake Meadows Walk



Fishlake Meadows nature reserve is located to the north of Romsey and is managed by the Hampshire & Isle of Wight Wildlife Trust in partnership with Test Valley Borough Council. The site covers over 60 hectares and is a spectacular wetland, home to ospreys, bitterns, migratory cuckoos, and murmurating starlings. It also supports other wildlife species, such as otters, water voles, over twenty types of dragonflies, and damselflies, plus an impressive variety of plants.

The unique habitats of Fishlake Meadows was originally drained farmland, when the pumps were switched off in the 1980s the site was swamped into a myriad of pools, ditches, reedbeds and wet grassland. The reserve now boasts a mix of floodplain habitats rarely seen in chalk river valleys. From the car park we walked northwards alongside the Andover Barge Canal, then turning left to walk along a path to viewing screens over the water meadows, returning back to the main footpath to reach the River Test and walking alongside it to reach a bridge over it. The footpath around the reserve ends there without doing some road walking to get back, so we retraced our steps back to the car park.
