Fritham is a small village in Hampshire, it lies in the north of the New Forest, near the Wiltshire border, it is in the civil parish of Bramshaw. The village is a dispersed settlement of cottages, farms, a small chapel and a picturesque 17th-century thatched pub called The Royal Oak, which is situated in a large, oval, medieval enclosure surrounded by forest and open heath. From around 1860 until the 1920s the Schultze Gunpowder Factory, which was based at nearby Eyeworth Lodge, employed many local people. They also provided a small black postbox still situated on the north side of the car park which was to make deliveries easier for the postman. Our walk took us from the car park in a south-westerly direction across Fritham Plain, walking over an open heathland footpath. We had views towards Amberwood and Sloden Inclosures to our right and Queen North Wood and Freeworms Hill to our left. We passed Green Pond on our way, then reached the outskirts of Sloden Inclosure at its southern most point where we had our picnic lunch. We had a view of Holly Hatch Cottage, a keepers cottage owned and managed by Forestry England. After lunch we retraced our steps back towards Fritham, upon reaching Green Pond a Cuckoo was heard and seen sitting in a distant tree.
